Camping fee is \$30.00 per night. Checks may be made payable to the Midwest Horse Fair®.

*Note: If you are staying Saturday night, you must vacate the grounds by 9:00 am on Sunday, August 19, 2012.*

## Camping Information:

- Camping is on a first-come, first-served basis and all fees must be paid in advance. Requests for specific sites cannot be honored. For safety reasons, once you have parked you must remain in the same spot the entire weekend.
- Overnight accommodations are available to Taking the Reins participants only: exhibitors, participants, Project Cowboy participants, performers, and clinicians.
- Check-in for camping is on Wednesday from 1 pm–8 pm and Thursday from 9 am–8 pm. **No arrival or camping is allowed on the grounds prior to 1 pm, Wednesday.** Grounds must be vacated by 9 am on Sunday.
- **All items** (this includes horses & any supplies, vendor supplies etc...) must be unloaded **BEFORE** you are able to park in the camping area. Security will be on-site throughout the weekend.
- All campers must have a Taking the Reins Camping Permit displayed. No person shall camp in any area except as designated and with prior approval.
- Electricity is very limited and not guaranteed. Please bring a 30 amp. turn around adapter and 200 ft. cords.
- **No** horses are allowed in paved camping area. Horses are **not** allowed on the grounds until Wed. at 1 pm.
- Cost of camping does not include admission, and must be purchased separately. Admission wristbands will be checked as you enter and exit the camping area.
- Cars & trucks in the camping area are for loading and unloading purposes only. Violators will be ticketed.
- The Alliant Energy Center is closed from midnight to 6 am. Quiet must be observed during these hours.
- No firearms, fireworks or dangerous weapons are permitted on the Alliant Energy Center premises.
- Fires are permitted only in campers' own charcoal grills. Hot coals may not be placed on the ground or in trash containers. All liquid and solid refuse must be placed in designated receptacles.
- Swimming, fishing and boating are not permitted in Alliant Energy Center ponds.
- No amplified noise is permitted without permission. No noisy, drunk or disorderly person shall be permitted to remain on the premises.
- Cancellations **after** July 2, 2012 are not eligible for a refund. Refund requests must be submitted in writing.
