Barn and Stall Guidelines



- Stalls will be assigned on a first-come, first-serve basis. Stall assignments will be sent in July 2012.
 - Trucks and trailers are not allowed around the barns during show hours.
 - Project Cowboy Participants may arrive on the grounds from **1:00 pm- 8:00 pm on Wednesday, August 15, 2012.**
 - Stalls must be vacated by **midnight on Saturday, August 18, 2012.**
 - Contestants may not hang any banners of any size in the stall area or arena promoting any sponsors.
 - Contestants may have brochures or small printed materials by their stall to promote their personal training business.

- Feed and shavings are the responsibility of the owner, however shavings will be available onsite to purchase.
 - **IMPORTANT INFORMATION:** All equine animals entering the grounds for Taking the Reins must have the following documentation (original plus a copy to submit to TTR staff)
 - Original **and a copy** of the laboratory report of a negative equine infectious anemia (EIA) test conducted **after January 1, 2012** which clearly identifies the equine animal by registration number, lip tattoo, or a complete description of the equine animal.
 - Original **and a copy** of the certificate of veterinary inspection issued within 30 days (**After July 16, 2012**) of Taking the Reins if you are coming from another state.
 - Smoking is not permitted in any of the barns.
 - Sales of any kind are not allowed.
 - Riding a horse inside the barns is not permitted. Keep aisles clear for horses and attendees to pass through.
 - Food cannot be prepared, given away, or sold to the public in the barns. This violates public health and safety rules and regulations. The only exception is food for yourself.
 - All participants are responsible for the care of their horse and are expected to arrive and be kept in show
 - Management requests that owners hang halters and lead lines in the front of the stall so that it is quickly available in case of an emergency.
 - Veterinarians are on-call, on-site, all weekend. Please contact them if any horse is having problems or needs attention. Do not care for anyone else's horse without the owner's permission.
 - Horses under saddle en route to any of the show arenas should be walked. Please use safety lanes & horse only lanes where indicated en route to the Coliseum or Arena.
 - Wristbands must be worn at all times and will be checked at the entrance to the grounds and at the arena gate area.
 - All participants must wear appropriate riding attire; no open-toed shoes are allowed.
 - Walking horses on the grass areas of Alliant Energy Center is not allowed. Horses are not allowed in the camping areas.
 - Not following the guidelines may alter or hinder participation.
